The Following Procedures Must Be Followed to Receive a TCC (Texas Chiropractic College) Course Transcript:

- Provide all information requested on the registration form and remit the \$30 processing fee for each convention attended.
- Scan in and out properly and on time - - failure to do so will result in not receiving ACBN credits or Allied CEU for that session.
- Arrive Early: Seating is limited on a “first come – first served” basis. Doors will be closed once the session is full.
- Your transcript will be sent via email directly from TCC. Be sure to add to your address book & watch your spam folder!
- **Allow 6-8 weeks for processing: if you have not received a transcript within 8 weeks after the convention, contact TCC by e/mail: Dr. Paul Jaskoviak at PJaskoviak@txchiro.edu**
- **NOTE:** it is your responsibility to keep track of documentation of CE Credits and hours accrued applicable toward earning your DACBN
- **Replacement /lost transcripts:** A \$25 TCC re-processing fee will apply for each individual transcript replacement requested

ACBN Clinical Nutrition Diplomate Candidate Qualifications:

- Licensed professional healthcare providers at the Doctoral level (DC)
- Successfully complete a minimum of 300 documented clock hours of specialized post-graduate clinical nutrition training sponsored by an accredited college, university or institution
- Submit 3 case histories & a nutrition-oriented article or paper accepted by the ACBN board for publication (publication is optional)
- 2 years clinical practice experience in clinical nutrition
- Successfully complete the ACBN written examination
- **It is the DACBN Candidate’s Responsibility to:**
 - 1) Complete all necessary course work
 - 2) Maintain their own class hour records
 - 3) Meet the ACBN Diplomate requirements
- TCC provides the accredited college transcripts required by the ACBN for FCA Convention sessions attended
