FL DC License Renewal Requirements: If this is NOT your first biennium renewal, you are required to accumulate 40 hours before March 31, 2026 in the following categories: 27 Clinical CE, 6 DOC, 2 MED, 2 ETH, 2 FLR, 1 RM. You may obtain more than the minimum number of hours in required sessions as long as your total number of hours for the biennium is at least 40. Each FCA CE event offers up to 20 hours in DC license renewal courses. The Board of Chiropractic Medicine added a 4-hour requirement ONLY for DC's certified in Acupuncture starting with biennium 2012-2014. These requirements must be in 2 hours of Acupuncture Technique & 2 hours of Acupuncture Risk Management (THIS DOES NOT FULFILL the general RM requirement for FL DC's).

FL CCPA License Renewal Requirements: Florida Certified Chiropractic Physicians' Assistants (CCPA's) are required to attend 24 hours of approved continuing education courses per licensure biennium, to include 2 hours in Prevention of Medical Errors. For your first biennium renewal, you must complete 2 hours MED and 3 hours HIV/AIDS. Each FCA CE event offers up to 12 hours of state-approved CE for CCPA's. To document your hours, attend any of the approved doctor courses and follow the attendance procedures described above.

* Required topics are placed in the largest space(s) available. Seating limited to number listed. Seating is first come, first served.

^ **In-class attendance.** RFID READERS are used to verify your attendance in this class.

¶ Beginning with biennium 2012-2014, the Board of Chiropractic Medicine added a 4-hour requirement ONLY for DC's certified in Acupuncture.

† Required topic for FIRST BIENNIUM FL DC license renewal (3 hrs AIDS/HIV, 2 hrs Prev. of Med. Errors, 6 hrs Recordkeeping/Documentation/Coding and 2 hrs Ethics).
